BY-LAW # 2011-32

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ERECTION OF A STOP SIGN AT AN INTERSECTION

WHEREAS section 137 of the *Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8* provides that the council of a municipality may by by-law provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction and every so sign erected shall comply with the regulations of the Ministry;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Nairn and Hyman hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule "A" and all notations thereon is hereby declared to form part of this By-law.
2. That the penalties provided in section 214 of the *Highway Traffic Act* apply to offences against this By-law.
3. That this By-law shall come into full force and effect on the date of its passing thereof.
