BY-LAW NUMBER 2001-17

**BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE THROWING, PLACING
OR DEPOSITING OF REFUSE OR DEBRIS ON PROPERTY OF
THE MUNICIPALITY**

WHEREAS pursuant to paragraph 82 of Section 210 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 as amended, by-laws may be passed by the Council for prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality of any local board thereof without authority from the owner or occupant of such property;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Nairn and Hyman **ENACTS** as follows:

Definitions:

1. In this by-law,
 - a) "Corporation" means the Corporation of the Township of Nairn and Hyman;
 - b) "Domestic Waste" includes household garbage, vegetables, fruits, furniture, clothing and household effects;
 - c) "Municipal Superintendent" means the Municipal Superintendent for the Township of Nairn and Hyman, or his designate;
 - d) "Officer" means a person appointed by by-law as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the Township of Nairn and Hyman;
 - e) "Owner" means the Corporation of the Township of Nairn and Hyman;
 - f) "Property" means lands, streets, sidewalks, bridges, parks, easements and any other public place in the Township;
 - g) "Refuse or debris" includes but is not limited to, garbage, ashes, rubbish, builder's and building contractors refuse, other industrial waste, inoperative vehicles and motor vehicle parts and accessories, glass and plastic bottles, plastic and paper cups and aluminum cans;
 - h) "Township" means the geographic entity of the Township of Nairn and Hyman;
 - i) "Township property" means any land situated within the Township which is owned by the Corporation or controlled by the Corporation by lease or otherwise;

Administration:

2. The Municipal Superintendent shall be responsible for administration and enforcement of this by-law.

Throwing of Refuse and Debris:

3. (1) No person shall throw, place or deposit refuse, debris or domestic waste on Township property without the written consent of the Corporation.

Signage:

4. The presence of a "No Dumping" sign shall be deemed to indicate a lack of consent on the part of the owner.

Penalty:

5. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence, and liable upon conviction, to a penalty under the Provincial Offences Act.
