

BY-LAW # 2008-13

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ERECTION OF A STOP SIGN AT INTERSECTIONS

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001,* (S.O. 2001, c.25) authorizes the Council to pass By-laws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways;

AND WHEREAS Section 137, of the *Highway Traffic Act,* R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8, as amended, provides that the council of a municipality may by by-law provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction and every sign so erected shall comply with the regulations of the Ministry;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Nairn and Hyman hereby enacts as follows:

1) The intersections on streets set out in Column 1 are designated as intersections where stop signs shall be erected at the location shown in Column 2.

Column 1 Intersection

<u>Column 2</u> Facing Traffic

Coal Dock Road and Sand Bay Road

Southbound on Sand Bay Road

2) Each designation made by Section 1 of this By-law shall become effective upon the erection of the stop sign, in accordance with the regulation of the *Highway Traffic Act*.
