power to prevent additional cuts during the upcoming review, and instead deal with financial issues by adding revenue-generating services like many other post offices around the world, including lucrative financial services

like bill payments, insurance and banking,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

that the Township of Nairn and Hyman write a letter to the Minister responsible for Canada Post to request that the government consider innovative ways to generate postal revenue during the Charter review, including financial services like bill payments, insurance and banking.
