YOUTH SMOKING PREVENTION

<u>ACT</u>

WHEREAS: each year, tobacco claims 13,000 lives in Ontario, the equivalent of 36 lives

every day; and

WHEREAS: the Sudbury and District Board of Health is accountable for the reduction in

youth access to tobacco products and priority populations adopting tobacco free living (Ontario Public Health Standards, 2008); and

WHEREAS: Bill 131, Youth Smoking Prevention Act, 2013, will strengthen the Smoke-

Free Act by making it more difficult for youth to obtain tobacco products, making tobacco products less tempting, and further limiting exposure to

second-hand smoke in public places; and

WHEREAS: the Sudbury & District Board of Health is joining efforts with other public

health agencies and provincial organizations in support of Bill 131, the Youth Smoking Prevention Act, 2013, and urge passage into law; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

that the Township of Nairn and Hyman supports the motion adopted by Sudbury & District Board of Health, motion 23-14, and recommends that all members of parliament work diligently towards final passage of this

important public health bill into law for Ontario; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

that this motion be forwarded to the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care, local MPP's, Assistant Deputy Minister, Health Promotion Division, Chief Medical Officer of Health, Federation of Northern Ontario Municipalities and the Association of Municipalities of Ontario.
