The Ontario Community Infrastructure Fund (OCIF) has approved our funding request for the McCharles Street construction project. Construction is due to commence soon.

### **LANDFILL**

As a reminder, the landfill is now open according to the summer hours until September 30, 2018:  
Wed. 8am – 12 pm & Sun. 12 Noon – 6 pm  
Any resident attending the landfill must present their landfill passes. If you have lost your pass, replacement passes can be obtained at the municipal office for a cost of \$5.00.

### **FIRE BANS**

Our fire chief is constantly monitoring weather and fire risk conditions. Should a fire ban be required all burn permit holders will be contacted and a notice will be posted on our website and Facebook page.

### **BUILDING PERMITS**

The building inspector is in the office on the following days:

Tuesdays – 9:00am – 11:30am

Wednesdays – 1:30pm – 4:00pm (Alternating weeks)

Fridays – 9:00am – 11:30am

NOTE: Please call ahead to ensure he is in the office as he performs inspections during these times.

If you require an inspection, please be sure to call or email at least 2 days in advance of when the inspection is required. If you wish to discuss your project with the inspector, please call or email to book an appointment.
