PURPOSE OF THE APPLICATION

The purpose of this minor variance application is to permit the construction of sleep cabin with a height of 6m (19.6 ft) where normally 4.5m (17.7ft) is permitted and a gross floor area of $60m^2$ (646 ft²) where normally $37m^2$ (400 ft²) is permitted.

MINOR VARIANCES ARE REQUIRED FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- Relief from Section 4.32 to permit the maximum gross floor area for a sleep cabin to be 60m²
- Relief from Section 5.6.2 to permit an accessory building with a height of 6m

The Subject Lands are not subject to any other application under the Planning Act.

MINOR VARIANCE DECISION

The Approval Authority, having considered the evidence presented and reviewed the plan and in consideration of all written and oral submissions made relating to the subject application, and having had regard to the matters set out in Section 45(1) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, is satisfied that, a minor variance from the provisions of the by-law, in respect of the land, building or structure or the use thereof, is minor, is desirable for the appropriate development or use of the land, building or structure, and the general intent and purpose of the by-law and of the official plan are maintained.

In so doing, it is the decision of the Approval Authority that: the application for constructing a sleep cabin having a maximum height of 6m and gross floor area of 60m², be **approved** with the following conditions:

• That the proposed sleep cabin be permitted with the height and gross floor area as noted above and be located and constructed as illustrated on the drawings as attached hereto and labelled Schedule 'A'.

A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group.
